CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND

THE TAREE SHOW SOCIETY IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION. ALL MONIES RAISED ARE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN THESE FACILITIES.

Taree Showground is a designated "Glass Free" area and **NO** glass drink containers are to be brought onto the site.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to search for any prohibited item including but not limited to weapons, controlled, dangerous or illegal substances, alcohol bottles and cans which may be expressly forbidden and subject to confiscation.

NO alcohol is to be consumed or carried in the Sideshow area.

No person under the legal drinking age is to attempt to purchase and / or consume any alcohol at the Showground. If of age, he or she will not consume such quantity of alcohol as would give rise to a blood reading above the legal limit allowable in the State for control of a motor vehicle, or such quantity which would adversely affect his/ her ability to drive a motor vehicle, whichever is lesser.

Alcohol must **ONLY** be consumed in the designated licence area.

Drunken, unruly, offensive behaviour or fighting will result in removal from the Showground.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to refuse admission without explanation and to eject any person whose conduct the Committee or a member of the Committee deems disorderly, unruly, offensive or any person who is adversely affected by alcohol or otherwise behaves in a violent or threatening manner.

Any person supplying alcohol to a person under the legal drinking age will be ejected from the Showground.

Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

The speed limit for vehicles within the Showground area is 10 kilometres per hour.

Any person ejected from or directed to leave the Showground is therefore banned from re-entering the Showground until such time as the Committee of the M.R.A. & H. Society (Taree) Inc. has lifted the ban. Such person shall thereafter be treated as a trespasser and Police will be notified.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Any Exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.

This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public. It is also a requirement of the Occupational Health & Safety Act of 1983.

The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any Exhibitors who DO NOT comply with the above instructions will not be allowed to exhibit at the TAREE SHOWGROUND.

Sheep Section Conditions of Entry

1. Entry Fee: \$1.00 (except in Classes 8,9 ,10 & 11) which are \$1.00 per class.) Rural Youth/JUNIOR HANDLER exempt from entry fee.
2. All sheep to be free from itch mite, ticks, lice & ked, foot abscess and footrot, and will be subject to inspection before being placed in a pen.
3. No exhibit allowed to compete in more than one class in any section, except where otherwise stated.
4. Sheep should be penned not later than 8.30 am.
5. Prize Money – Supreme Ribbons & Trophy.
6. Judging to commence at 9.00 am on the day of the show.
7. Only Brucellosis tested flocks will be accepted. Accreditation proof (copy of Certificate) must be produced with entry.
8. All exhibits to be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor and to have been in their possession for at least 3 months prior to the Show.
9. All Exhibitors are required to complete a Waiver Form (attached) and return with your entries.
10. **Junior handler must be under the age of 16.**
