

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND

THE TAREE SHOW SOCIETY IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION.

ALL MONIES RAISED ARE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN THESE FACILITIES.

Taree Showground is a designated "Glass Free" area and NO glass drink containers are to be brought onto the site.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to search for any prohibited item including but not limited to weapons, controlled, dangerous or illegal substances, alcohol bottles and cans which may be expressly forbidden and subject to confiscation.

NO alcohol is to be consumed or carried in the Sideshow area.

No person under the legal drinking age is to attempt to purchase and / or consume any alcohol at the Showground. If of age, he or she will not consume such quantity of alcohol as would give rise to a blood reading above the legal limit allowable in the State for control of a motor vehicle, or such quantity which would adversely affect his/her ability to drive a motor vehicle, whichever is lesser.

Alcohol must ONLY be consumed in the designated licence area.

Drunken, unruly, offensive behaviour or fighting will result in removal from the

Showground.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to refuse admission without explanation and to eject any person whose conduct the

Committee or a member of the Committee deems disorderly, unruly, offensive or any person who is adversely affected by alcohol or otherwise behaves in a violent or threatening manner.

Any person supplying alcohol to a person under the legal drinking age will be ejected from the Showground.

Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

The speed limit for vehicles within the Showground area is 10 kilometres per hour.

Any person ejected from or directed to leave the Showground is therefore banned from re-entering the Showground until such time as the Committee of the M.R.A. & H. Society (Taree) Inc. has lifted the ban. Such person shall thereafter be treated as a trespasser and Police will be notified.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All the Exhibits must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor. The Chief Steward reserves the right to request and inspect ownership and stud registration papers.

2. The 1st of October 2023 is the reference date for the calculation of Age of an animal.

3. On any protest relative to age, the Judge reserves the right to mouth any Exhibit and make the final decision.

4. All Exhibits must be available for inspection to persons nominated by the Society at any time - for any reasons.

5. Exhibitors must supply particulars regarding name, breed and age of the animal on the entry form.

6. Open to all registered pure beef breeds registered with their respective breed societies.

7. The Society will not hold itself responsible for any loss or miss delivery of livestock or other Exhibits at the Show or damage there to.

8. Overnight accommodation is available from 4pm on the day prior to the Show in the designated area at the advertised rate – NOT in the cattle stalling area.

9. All cattle must be on the grounds by 8am SATURDAY 7th October 2023.

10. If any Exhibit/Exhibitor is not ready to parade when the class is called, then the class will go ahead without the Exhibit/Exhibitor.

11. All Beef cattle must be haltered and led with an approved nose grip fitted. All Bulls over the age of 12 months must have a nose ring fitted.

12. Handlers must be OVER 12 years of age to lead a Bull.

13. The calf of an exhibit must parade with its mother if it is NOT over nine (9) months.

14. Neck straps must be used on all cattle stalled overnight in the Beef Cattle sheds.

15. Sawdust bedding is provided by the Society; any other bedding is prohibited.

16. All entries are subject to the General Rules and regulations of the Society.

17. Any matter arising that is not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Chief Steward.

18. ALL cattle must be fitted with NLIS ear tags.

19. Beef Cattle Herd Health Status Declaration MUST accompany Entry forms. Any exhibit NOT covered by this declaration will NOT be permitted on the grounds.

19. ALL EXHIBITORS & ATTENDANTS are required to sign a Waiver Form with their entries. Forms are included with this schedule. ENTRIES NOT accompanied by these signed forms will NOT be accepted.

20. ALL cattle (including calves at foot) must be tested for Pestivirus as Non P.I. A copy of a signed Vet Certificate or Lab Report is required with the Entry Form.

21. A Heifer is considered a female that is older than 9 months and under 24 months that has not had a calf as at 1 October 2023.

22. No refund of entry fees shall be made after the closing date of entries.

23. All electrical equipment must have a current tag of compliance.

24. Electrical leads laying on the ground across laneways, aisles, or any pedestrian and/or cattle traffic area is strictly prohibited.

BEEF CATTLE JUDGING COMPETITION

RULES & REGULATIONS

a) Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1st May in the year of the State Final at the Royal Easter Show. They must be living in NSW or be in regular paid employment there or be in full time education in NSW at the time of first competing in any competition year.

b) Once a competitor has qualified to represent a Group at Sydney Royal Show in any one of the Judging or Parading Competition State Finals, he/she may not enter another Group Final as a potential qualifier in that type of competition in that competition year. He/She can, however, enter any one or more Group Finals anywhere in the state, for practice (and score), in the same type of competition as one in which he/she has previously qualified as long as he/she discloses this to the Group Final organizers at the time of entry and indicates that he/she is not eligible for a placing in that event. ("qualified" means First in Merino Sheep, First or Second in Meat Breeds Sheep, Merino Fleece, Beef Cattle and Grain, and First, Second or Third in Dairy Cattle and Fruit and Vegetables. In Beef Cattle Paraders, "qualified" means gaining one of the placings which the particular Group Final is entitled to award based on the scale of entries. The Stud Merino Breeders Association competitions in Merino Sheep Judging at Armidale, Canberra and Dubbo are classed as Group Finals.)

c) No competitor can represent more than one show society in any one Group Final and no more than one group in a State Final. The winners of National Finals cannot compete thereafter at any level in the particular competition that they won.

d) Winners of two (2) State Finals in any one class shall not be eligible for future competitions in that class.

e) The Hormel Slide or the Computerized Scoring System is to be used at all Group and State Finals.

f) Groups are entitled to be represented at State level by two (2) competitors unless otherwise stated.

g) Group Secretaries must inform the ASC of the name, date of birth, address and telephone number of any competitor in judging competitions going on to State Finals. The ASC will advise these competitors of the venue and times of the State Final. In addition, a complete list of all competitors in a Group Final must be sent to the ASC the next working day after the competition.

h) After the competition is over and awards have been given, the competitors can look at their scores on the master sheet only.

i) Competitors will be eliminated from the competition if deemed by the Chief Steward to be receiving outside assistance.
