

TAREE SHOW JUNIOR SHOWGIRL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. The Competition is open to those who are permanent residents of Australia.
2. Entrants must be women aged from 12 years to less than 17 years as at 1 May 2025.
3. Entrants must reside, be educated, or work within New South Wales for at least three months prior to their local competition to qualify to compete within the State.
4. Previous entrants in the competition are eligible to enter.
5. The following people are not eligible to enter the competition: a. Staff, Directors and Councillors of the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW ("RAS"). b. The daughters of the Staff, Directors and Councillors of the RAS. c. Current Rural Achiever applicants for the 2025 Sydney Royal Show
6. The winner is requested, where possible, to represent their local Show Society at agricultural shows.
7. All entrants are to abide by the Code of Conduct, as set out by the Manning River Agricultural & Horticultural Society Taree Inc.

Have your Entry Form, Consent Form, Media Release & Photo submitted by **8th September 2024**.

Attend the Judging on Saturday **21st September 2024**

Attend the **Taree Show on Saturday 12th October** & if possible Sunday 13th October 2024
